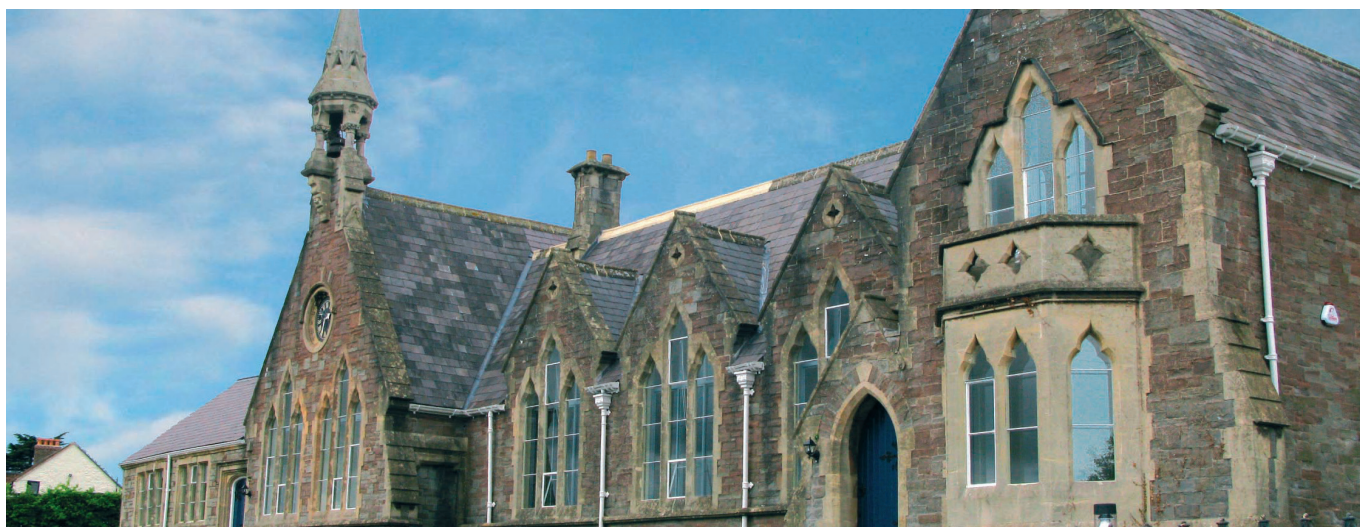

panels incorporating specialist low emissivity glass to minimise heat loss. The secondary glazing has also markedly reduced ambient noise levels, further improving the environment within the apartments.

Built in 1862, Northleaze CofE Primary School, located 3 miles from Bristol's city centre, has been converted into shared ownership accommodation by Knightstone Housing.

Originally consisting of 2 classrooms and the Master's House, the new development comprises 5 unique apartments, several with mezzanine open plan bedrooms and all retaining elements of the fixtures and features of the original school.

The windows, much in gothic style, had to be retained but there was also a critical need to improve thermal insulation and meet Building Regulation standards and the local authority's Conservation Officer agreed to the use of secondary glazing.

Working in conjunction with the design team and the contractors Gadd construction, Selectaglaze produced a range of complementary hinged, fixed and sliding
